

Specific, goal-oriented and time-limited programs and services including:

Walk-in Clinic: Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday from 12:00 (noon) until 6:00 p.m.;

Crisis intervention;

Psychiatric, psychological and behavioural consultation;

Service coordination, including identification of needs and links to treatment and supports;

Interdisciplinary treatment for children, youth, and families; parent and family counseling; therapeutic groups for children, youth, and parents;

Intensive family treatment;

Community based services: Home and school interventions, school/ agency conferences, in-school training;

Milieu treatment (residential and day) for pre-adolescent children;

Services for youth involved in the justice system

How To Make A Referral

- 1. Obtain an Intake Package from Regional Children's Centre. Once the package is completed and returned to our centre, the child will then be assigned to a service coordinator who will help plan your family treatment needs.
- 2. If you have an urgent need and would like to see a therapist (single session of counselling), please attend our Walk-in Clinic (Monday, Tuesday, & Thursday from 12 pm to 6 pm). If at the end of the session you wish to proceed with services at our centre, an intake package will be provided.
- Physicians, schools and other agencies can refer by directing parents to pick up an Intake Package.

Parents may also call the Centre at 519-257-5215 for more direction.

Although every effort will be made to provide services as quickly as possible, there may be a wait for services to begin.
