- **Connecting clients to wrap-around supports** to address the determinants of health

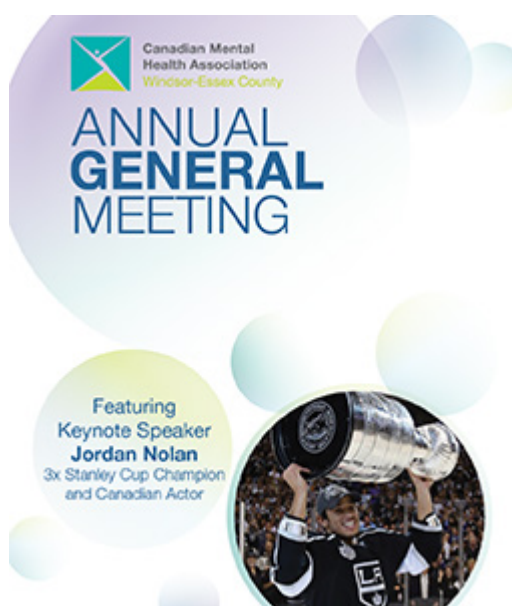
